in the area when the tragic events of the September 11th Trade Center disaster occurred. Time had frozen and the world was in shock. Plans were temporarily put on hold.

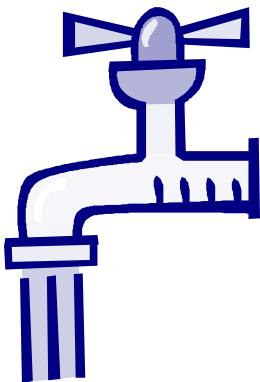

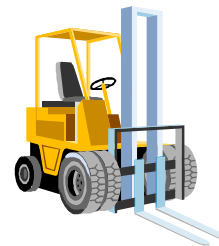
## Subdivision Management

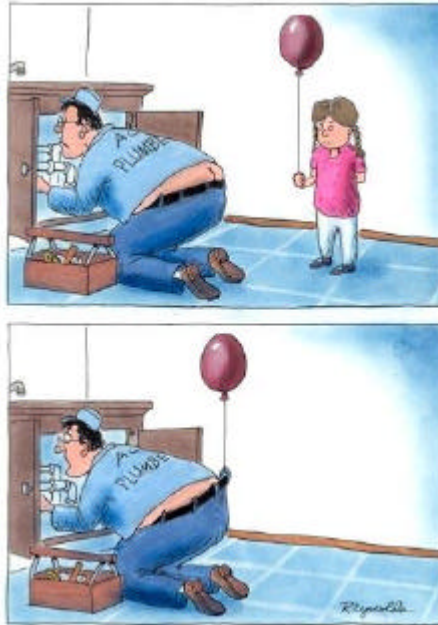
In the coming weeks, Nextel representatives will be visiting the Clermont and Summerfield locations to test for problems and discuss possible solutions with our company.

Sean Edwards (Supervisor) has returned from his offsite location in Avalon Park to the Orlando shop. He will be working out of our main office for the foreseeable future.



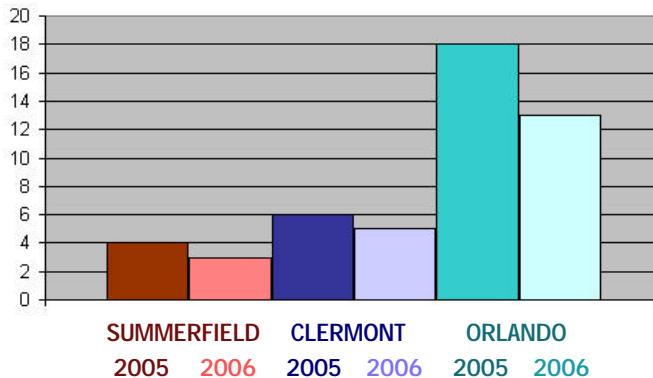
