
## Heavy Equipment News

# Why are We called Plumbers?

When cities first started using pipes to carry water for irrigation and sanitation, the pipes were often made of lead. Because the Latin word for lead is *plumbum*, this piping system

came to be referred to as plumbing.

Luckily, we no longer move water through lead pipes. Many people died from poisoning associated with lead, including King Tut. But don't just blame the pipes! People also used lead in pottery, especially in their drinking vessels. Those wealthy enough to afford leaded



goblets and dishware were more susceptible to this type of death. Today, lead has been removed from many of the products that once contained it. Pipes, pottery, gasoline and paint have all become lead-free... though plumbers can still trace their name back to this usage.
