This years company picnic will be held on November 12, 2006.





SAFETY TIPS: The Heat is On

We have reached the time of the year when working outdoors makes heat stress a serious concern. It is important to know how to protect yourself from the heat and what to do if you or one of your co-workers gets overheated.

There are two main kinds of heat illness: Heat Stroke and Heat Exhaustion. Learn the difference between the two and know what to do.

Heat Stroke: Flushed, dry skin, a rapid heartbeat, loud rapid breathing and a high body temperature. May complain of dizziness and headache or may suffer from convulsions. **Action:** Someone should call 911 and try to get the victim cooled off.

Heat Exhaustion: Sweating profusely and has pale clammy skin. Body temperature is normal. The victim may feel tired, nervous, headachy, and may vomit or faint. May have cramps from lack of salt. Action: Move the victim to a cool place and drink cool water.

Prevent Heat Related Illness: If you are not used to working in the heat, start out slowly. Save strenuous tasks for cooler times of the day. Drink plenty of water-at least 8-ounces every 20-30 minutes. Avoid carbonated drinks. Try to cut out high-fat foods out of your diet and get plenty of rest. Wear loose, light color clothing and a hat if you are outdoors. If you are not feeling good, take a break.
